The steps are short enough to copy fully below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Election results from Montana Secretary of State (<a href="https://sosmt.gov/elections/results/">https://sosmt.gov/elections/results/</a>)</li> <li>○ Precinct shapefile primarily from Dave Ritts at the Montana State Library, as prepared for submission to the U.S. Census Bureau's 2020 Redistricting Data Program.</li> <li>○ The three precincts in Treasure County were merged as the county transitioned to a single countywide precinct prior to the 2020 election.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● We were able to follow these steps.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Information not in their processing steps:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● List of name changes for precincts between election results and VEST's file.</li> </ul>
<p>Able to replicate joining election data and shapefiles?</p> <p>Yes</p>	<p>Yes, we were able to replicate joining election data and shapefiles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● There were initially 666 precinct shapefiles and 663 precinct election results.</li> <li>● After the name changes listed above all but 3 zero vote precincts were able to be joined.</li> <li>● Assigned the names 'FLATHEAD-1', 'FLATHEAD-2', and 'LAKE-1' to both the VEST file and the shapefile for the 3 zero vote precincts. The files were then able to be fully joined.</li> </ul>

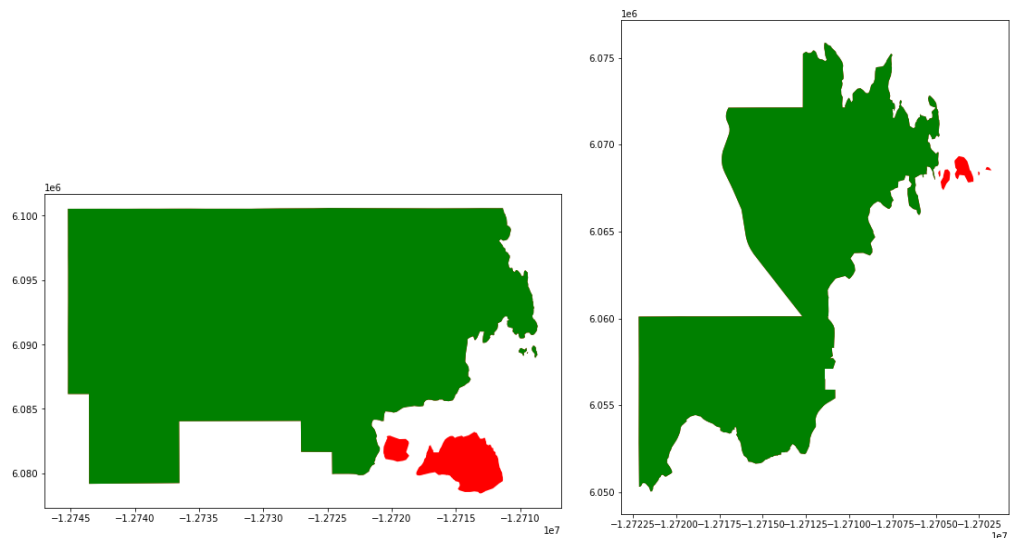

**Election results:**

- We validated the election results at the state, county and precinct levels.
- At the state-level, candidate vote totals matched exactly. The statewide race totals also matched the totals from the State Canvass report ([https://sosmt.gov/wp-content/uploads/State\\_Canvass\\_Report.pdf](https://sosmt.gov/wp-content/uploads/State_Canvass_Report.pdf)) on the MT SOS website.
- At the county-level, candidate vote totals matched exactly.
- At the precinct-level, candidate votes also matched exactly.

**Geographies:**

- 31 precincts w/ a difference of 0 km<sup>2</sup>
- 569 precincts w/ a difference between 0 and 0.1 km<sup>2</sup>
- 58 precincts w/ a difference between 0.1 and 0.5 km<sup>2</sup>
- 5 precincts w/ a difference between 0.5 and 1 km<sup>2</sup>
- 1 precincts w/ a difference between 1 and 2 km<sup>2</sup>
- 2 precincts w/ a difference between 2 and 5 km<sup>2</sup>
- 0 precincts w/ a difference greater than 5 km<sup>2</sup>
- The largest differences in the shapefiles concern Flathead lake. It appears that VEST assigned islands (red) in Flathead lake to precincts "DAY 1 HD12" and "POL 2 HD12".



- Other differences greater than 0.1km<sup>2</sup> appear to be boundary differences and can be seen in the notebook.
