The source for the RDH votes for most of the Other presidential results are from OpenElections, which is the same for VEST. However, the SOS does not report as many Other votes. Since the SOS does not provide the precinct-level election results for 4 large counties in the state (Johnson, Sedgwick, Shawnee, and Wyandotte), we cannot validate the Other votes.

The election results for all other Presidential and U.S. Senate candidates did match the SOS totals.

At the county total level, the election results did not match VEST's. Kansas does not provide a county level election summary report to compare these results to.

The election results only did not match for the G16PREOTH field, with differences only in Miami, Shawnee, and Sumner counties of 24, 341 and -37 votes respectively (VEST totals minus our totals).
