Election results validated for every candidate statewide?

No

For the precinct-level file that we were able to download, precinct vote totals that equaled less than 5 votes were obfuscated. As a result, at the statewide total level, the election results did not match VEST's. Our totals also did not match those of New Mexico's election summary report (https://electionresults.sos.state.nm.us/default.aspx?eid=2698), but VEST's did.

We are not sure if VEST obtained an election results file without these obfuscations or whether they allocated the votes back into the data somehow.

The county-level election results matched VEST's.

Election results validated for every candidate by county?

Yes

At the county total level, the precinct-level election results did not match VEST's due to the obfuscated votes. The county totals also did not match those of New Mexico's election summary report

(https://electionresults.sos.state.nm.us/default.aspx?eid=2698). VEST's election results and the state summary report matched.

At the precinct level, the election results did not match VEST's (1300 out of 1492 precincts matched).



validated for every candidate by precinct?

Yes

The differences appear to be caused mainly by the missing record of votes. The average difference was ~3 votes and the max difference between the election results and VEST was 5 votes and any precinct with a difference had no more than 5 votes for that candidate, so all differences are due to obfuscations.

There have been a few minor changes to all the precinct names in both VEST and election results to match the way the precinct names were written. Then 7 of the precincts required second minor name changes.
