Election results validated for every candidate statewide? Yes	At the statewide total level, the election results matched VEST's. The totals also matched those of Oklahoma's election summary report (<u>https://results.okelections.us/OKER/?elecDate=20161108</u>).
Election results validated for every candidate by county? Yes	At the county total level, the election results matched VEST's. The county totals also matched those of Oklahoma's election summary report (<u>https://results.okelections.us/OKER/?elecDate=20161108</u>).
Election results validated for every candidate by precinct? Yes	At the precinct level, the election results matched VEST's (1956 out of 1956 precincts matched). Early votes were reported countywide for Oklahoma County and Tulsa County. These were distributed by candidates to precincts based on their share of the precinct-level reported vote. As a result two precincts were created by the SOS which were redistributed to the precincts located in their respective counties.
