Yes	 Description of processing steps: VEST's documentation file, accessed 6/29/2021: "Election results from Arizona Secretary of State (https://azsos.gov/2020-election-information) Precinct shapefile from Arizona Secretary of State via personal communication except Greenlee County is sourced from the county shapefile instead. The following modifications were made to match the precinct boundaries for the 2020 general election. Apache: Merge Puerco East/West La Paz: Merge Alamo into Wenden Maricopa: Merge South Mtn Park E, NE, S, SE, SW into South Mtn Park" There were no processing steps missing in our validation of the election results. Information not in their processing steps: We are not able to confirm whether any information is missing from their processing steps, because the raw shapefile that VEST collected is not publicly available from VEST or the SOS.

We did not attempt to join the election results to the raw shapefile, because we do not have the 2020 raw shapefile that VEST used for this file. Given that we are missing the raw file, we are unable to validate the join of the election results and the shapefile itself.

The totals also matched those of Arizona's election summary report listed above. ● At the precinct-level, the election results we cleaned from the SOS match VEST's in all 1,489 precincts.
