Election results validated for every candidate statewide?	At the statewide total level, the election results matched VEST's. The totals also match those of RI's statewide summary file (https://www.ri.gov/election/results/2020/general_election/).
Election results validated for every candidate by county? Yes	At the county total level, the election results matched VEST's with the exception of several counties being off by 1-10 votes (with one race/county combo exception of 12 votes) - For full list of differences, check the notebook The totals, however, still match up. This difference of mostly less than 10 votes is likely a result of different methods for distributing federal level votes - which may result in some votes being distributed more heavily towards one township as opposed to another. RI does not have a county-level summary file to compare against.
Election results validated for every candidate by precinct? Yes	At the precinct level, the election results matched VEST's in 191 out of 421 precincts. Of the 230 precincts with vote differences, 210 precincts had a max vote difference of 1 and 20 precincts had a max vote difference of 2, which could be attributed to VEST's specific methodology and rounding for vote allocation. There were also two zero-vote precincts in VEST's file that did not appear in the election results file. No precinct name changes were required - precinct ID's were used.
