

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	<ul> <li>Hamilton was drawn based on a geocoded voter registration file.</li> <li>Edits were made to Brevard, Charlotte, Escambia, Franklin, Indian River, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lake, and Lee, Miami-Dade, and St. Johns based on the voter registration file.</li> <li>Lake 108, Osceola 999, Palm Beach 8002, Seminole 900s, and Monroe's "Cumulative" precinct (the latter appears on the county's detailed results but not the DOS's precinct results file) don't have geography. Brevard 999, Broward Z073, Collier 450, Flagler 999, Hillborough 999, Leon 9000, Miami-Dade 100, and Pinellas 512 do have geography, but they are just the county election offices. Both groups represent some type of vote not assigned to a particular geography, like UOCAVA results, so these were distributed across the county by candidate proportional to the vote each precinct recorded.</li> <li>Information not in their processing steps</li> <li>If there are no processing steps, write No available processing steps</li> </ul>	
Able to replicate joining election data and shapefiles? No	<ul> <li>No, given the documentation they provided we would not be able to follow their steps to complete the join because we were not able to obtain shapefiles in the following counties: <ul> <li>Broward, Gadsden, Gilchrist, Manatee, Nassau, Santa Rosa, St. Johns, St. Lucie, and Union. VEST used the Orlando Sentinel's map as a starting point for these counties, but we did not attempt to geocode that map.</li> <li>VEST used a geocoded voter registration file to create the Hamilton County precinct shapefile which we did not locate.</li> <li>VEST used county sources for DeSoto, Gulf, Sumter, and Polk counties. For these counties, we were unable to find either precinct maps or shapefiles.</li> <li>For Marion, Highlands, Lake, Osceola, Volusia, Columbia, and Duval Counties, we were able to find precincts maps but not shapefiles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>However, in the counties where we did have precinct shapefiles, available we were able to join 4167 precincts, with 134 precinct shapefiles and 44 precinct election results unjoined. A handful of trivial precinct name changes and mergers were required for this join.</li> </ul>

No	<ul> <li>Election results: Yes</li> <li>We validated election results at three different levels: <ul> <li>Statewide candidate vote totals</li> <li>Countywide candidate vote totals</li> <li>Precinct-level candidate votes</li> </ul> </li> <li>At the statewide total level, the election results did not match VEST's. VEST's file has 15 more G20PRETRU votes, 9 more G20PREDBID votes, and 1 more G20PRELJOR vote. VEST's totals matched those of FL's election summary report</li> <li>(https://results.elections.myflorida.com/DetailRpt.Asp?ELECTIONDATE=11/3/ 2020&amp;RACE=PRE) in every race except for G20PREDBID votes, and 1 more G20PRELJOR vote. It election results did not match VEST's. VEST's file has 10 more G20PRETRU votes, 5 more G20PREDBID votes, and 1 more G20PRELJOR vote in Monroe County and 5 more G20PRETRU votes and 4 more G20PREDBID votes in Seminole County. VEST's totals matched those of FL's election summary report</li> <li>At the countywide total level, the election results did not match VEST's. VEST's file has 10 more G20PRETRU votes, 5 more G20PREDBID votes, and 1 more G20PREDBID votes in Seminole County. VEST's totals matched those of FL's election summary report</li> <li>(https://results.elections.myflorida.com/DetailRpt.Asp?ELECTIONDATE=11/3/ 2020&amp;RACE=PRE) in every race except for G20PREDWRI, as the summary report does not contain every write-in vote.</li> <li>At the precinct-level, the election results matched VEST's in 5968 of 5990 precincts. The 22 precincts with differences are all in Monroe and Seminole County and contain a maximum difference of 1 vote.</li> </ul>

#### <u>Geographies:</u> No

- We were not able to obtain shapefiles, and thus not able to validate precinct geometries, in the following counties:
  - Broward, Gadsden, Gilchrist, Manatee, Nassau, Santa Rosa, St. Johns, St. Lucie, and Union. VEST used the Orlando Sentinel's map as a starting point for these counties, but we did not attempt to geocode that map.
  - VEST used a geocoded voter registration file to create the Hamilton County precinct shapefile which we did not locate.
  - VEST used county sources for DeSoto, Gulf, Sumter, and Polk counties. For these counties, we were unable to find either precinct maps or shapefiles.
  - For Marion, Highlands, Lake, Osceola, Volusia, Columbia, and Duval Counties, we were able to find precincts maps but not shapefiles.
  - In FL's other counties, where we were able to locate precinct shapefiles, were able to validate 4227 precincts (out of 6010 total precincts in VEST's file):
    - 1173 precincts w/ a difference of 0 km^2
    - $\circ~~2796$  precincts w/ a difference between 0 and .1 km^2
    - 38 precincts w/ a difference between .1 and .5 km^2
    - 26 precincts w/ a difference between .5 and 1 km^2
    - $\circ$  33 precincts w/ a difference between 1 and 2 km<sup>2</sup>
    - $\circ$  40 precincts w/ a difference between 2 and 5 km<sup>2</sup>
    - 77 precincts w/ a difference greater than 5 km^2
- Due to the variety of sources for precinct shapefiles, the number of precincts with a difference between 0 and .1 km^2 is not surprising.
- VEST also notes that in their documentation that "Edits were made to Brevard, Charlotte, Escambia, Franklin, Indian River, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lake, and Lee, Miami-Dade, and St. Johns based on the voter registration file."
